# Recycle!

All Clean Paper—  
May be placed in a Paper Sack.  
**(Do not use plastic bags)**

- Includes: Most all clean paper.
- Things like:
  - Magazines
  - Newspaper
  - Phonebooks
  - Junkmail
  - Catalogues
  - Cereal Boxes
  - Detergent Boxes
  - Greeting Cards
  - School Papers
  - Paperback Books
  - Wrapping Paper
  - Paper Egg Cartons

Corrugated cardboard.  
Break down flat to save space.

- NO! Do not include:**  
Any soiled paper or these non-recyclable items:
  - Styrofoam
  - Tissue
  - Paper
  - Plastic
  - Bags
  - Diapers
  - Hardbound Books
  - Rubber Bands
  - Paper Plates

**NO! Glass bottles or jars.**  
(www.OmahaRecycles.com to find a drop-off site)

Containers—Loose in the cart  
**(Not in plastic bags)**

- Gable top and Aseptic cartons including—juice boxes, milk cartons, juice cartons, and soup or broth boxes.
- Aluminum cans and Steel (tin) cans including—food cans, empty aerosol cans, empty and dry paint cans with lid removed.  
Tip: Place the top of food cans inside can and crimp closed.

Plastic containers and packaging marked



Caps and lids are OK. Includes:
 

- Bottles
- Cups
- Snap top container
- Clamshell deli containers
- Cookie trays
- DVD cases
- Clear plastic packaging
- Microwave meal trays

**NO! Don't recycle these plastic items, no matter what:**

Toys, plastic bags, motor oil bottles, lawn chemical bottles, or hazardous chemical bottles.
